Dr. Bo Cui currently serves as Executive Editor in Chief of five academic journals including *Journal of Acute Disease*, *Asia Pacific Journal of Reproduction*, *Asia Pacific Journal of Tropical Medicine*, *Asia Pacific Journal of Tropical Biomedicine*, and *One Health Bulletin*. He is also an adjunct professor at Shantou University School of Medicine. He received his graduate education in the USA and Canada with MA in English, MSc and PhD in microbiology and immunology. His professional experience includes work at Duke University Medical Center and Li Ka-shing Foundation. Before his current position, Dr. Cui served as Executive Editor of the *Journal of Biomedical Research* and deputy editor of the *Journal of International Translational Medicine* and a Distinguished Professor at Nanjing Medical University.
